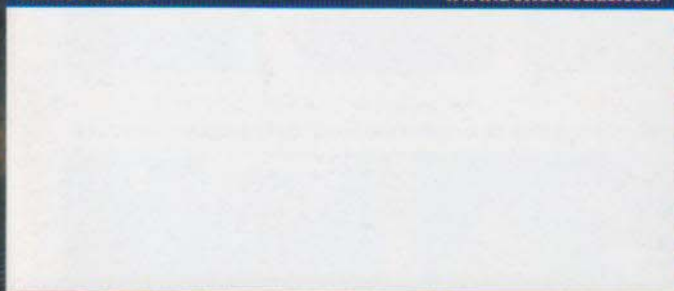

CeeLite/Signal Service LEC-illuminated street signs

A distribution agreement between Signal Service and CeeLite has brought Light Emitting Capacitor (LEC) illuminated street signs to a five-state area. The signs are less than 0.25-inch thick, lightweight, and extremely durable, according to the manufacturer. The signs are "remarkably visible at night and in inclement weather, yet do not glare or create a distraction to drivers or the community," according to CeeLite. The LEC technology also is cost efficient to operate because of its low power consumption.

Nesco Wheel wash system

Nesco's DirtSquirt Wheel Wash System blasts dirt from truck tires, eliminating dust and dirt buildup on trucks leaving construction and mining sites. The system is equipped with galvanized dual-action spray manifolds and 200-psi nozzles, but uses less than 60 gallons of water per truck. It can be installed as a stationary wash or housed in a trailer with a surge tank for portable applications. The spray nozzles can be configured to wash tires alone, or used in conjunction with the truck body and undercarriage.
